- (2) Junior Membership - \$22.00 - Shall include all persons up to and including 17 years of age.
- (3) If dues are paid by the March 31st deadline, an active member shall **receive a \$10.00 discount.**
- (4) If an active member has not paid his/her dues by the end of April, he/she will be treated as a new member and must repeat the club application process.
